



## Paul S. Lietman Travel Grant for Medical Housestaff

### APPLICATION FOR GRANT EXTENSION

Version/Date: 2/15 August 2017

---

**Purpose:** Recipients of the Paul S. Lietman Travel Grant are eligible to apply for an extension of their award period and request additional funding. This funding is intended to support continued work in a low- or middle-income country (LMIC) for housestaff who want to establish careers in global health. **You do not have to work in the same country, but you must justify how the new work is directly related to the work done under the original award.**

**Eligibility:** You are eligible to apply if you received a Lietman award and completed your return requirements. At the time of application for the extension, you must be a full-time **fellow** in any GME program at Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine.

**Award amount:** Awards will range from \$1,500-3,000. Awards cannot be used for travel that occurred before the award date.

**Requirements:** You will be expected to complete the same reporting requirements as for your original award at the end of your extension. See [here](#) for more details.

- What cycle you received your original Lietman Award (e.g. Spring 2017)
- A brief description (1 paragraph) of what you did during your original Lietman award. Please include details about activities, places, dates, and local collaborators.
- A brief description of why you want to return or continue activities.
- Country where you plan to work
- What you will be doing and who you will be working with.
- Proposed budget
- Timeline of activities
