The Matching Process

how it works

You rank 3 sites when you apply (in preference order)

all three sites receive your application materials

sites have 1 month to interview (or not)



most matches made are 1 to 1 (your first choice also picked you first)

sites return their preferences in order

you can change your ranking order (but not add new sites)



next is 2 to 1 your first choice, their second, and so on.

we keep going until all possible matches are made

placements are offered to students and awards are made
